The Household Energy Survey

Light Foot Enterprises has developed the Household Energy Survey over the last 15 years and to date over 2000 surveys have been carried out.

The purpose of the survey is to inform people how much energy they consume in their home and to suggest low cost ways that this consumption and carbon footprint can be reduced.

We did a number of resurveys with householders in Wales and found that the households who had implemented the recommendations suggested in their reports were benefiting and had been able to reduce their energy consumption by a significant amount.
